REQUIREMENTS	ACTIONS
Wellbeing of staff and congregants	
Exclude staff and congregants who are unwell from the premises.	Staff and potential visitors will be advised to return home if unwell.
Provide staff with information and training on COVID-19, including when to get tested, physical distancing and cleaning.	We will continue to provide information and training to staff on COVID-19 including requests for them to be tested prior to returning to the site if they have been a close contact or have been unwell.

Capacity limits

There are no capacity limits and most venues are open to everyone.

Mask wearing

Masks are now only required on public transport, planes and at airports, or for front-of-house hospitality staff who are not double vaccinated, however wearing a mask continues to be encouraged indoors and where people cannot socially distance.

People may choose to wear a mask if they wish to do so. They will be provided at the front entrance of the premises for anyone who is in need.
